Even in his twilight years, Popcorn was still trekking up the mountain in his dungarees and straw hat to brew one last batch of hooch for his mates. The man was no oil painting — but by God he was popular.

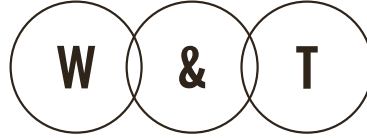
