The man was no oil painting — but by God he was popular.

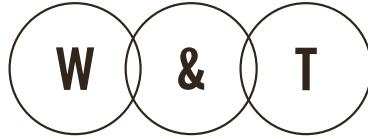

Very sweet with a mixture of corn, brown sugar, and tobacco.

High heat on the palate with fresh fruit, black pepper and clove. The medium/long finish is brimming with big red gum and a hint of leather.

Vanilla and sweet corn with strong notes of varnish, oak, and alcohol heat, giving way to charred orange, brown sugar and dried fruits.

Big cherry, pumpernickel, vanilla, caramel, leather and sweet spice. There's also a sweet, bready quality to this one with pleasant citrus - like a lemon and poppy seed muffin.
